Player Code of Conduct:

All St. James players will govern themselves according to the following Code of Conduct, which includes but is not limited to the following:

- Players are committed to the team for the entire season and the duration of playoffs.
- Players will have the appropriate uniform and equipment.
- Players will arrive prepared and on time to all games and practices.
- Players will follow the coaches' instructions and give their best effort at all games and practices.

- Coaches are the designated team representatives and they will be the only ones to address any issues with the umpire. Players will not argue balls, strikes, or any other judgment calls.
- Players who address a question or concern to the coach will do so in a respectful manner at an appropriate time.
- Players are responsible for their own personal property. The team is not responsible for lost or stolen personal property.
- Players will conduct themselves in an honest and respectful manor on and off the field while representing St James Minor Baseball.
- Players are expected to remember that it is a privilege to play the game of baseball and be a member of St. James Minor Baseball.
- Players will wear their St. James Baseball jersey during all games or events of competition with pride, and will project a favorable image of SJAMBA.
